The Graham County Child Care Health Consultant will promote healthy and safe



environments for children in child care settings through consultation, training, and technical assistance services.

Car Seat Safety

Provides a certified Child Passenger Safety Technician to teach how to install and remove infant and child car seats, per NC Child Restraint and Seat Belt laws.

Environmental Health

Protects public health through inspections of restaurants, motels, schools, swimming pools, daycare facilities, and more. Performs water sampling. **It is recommended anyone with a private drinking supply have it checked annually.** The environmental health specialist completes inspections for sewage disposal systems design, and well construction. Manages animal control. Coordinates rabies clinics, and provides education about environmental safety.

Tuberculosis Control/Medical Services

The goal of the NC TB Program is to eliminate TB disease as a public health threat by reducing the number of TB cases and by controlling the spread of TB into the community.

Community Preparedness (Bio-terrorism)

Plans and coordinates working with the community for preparation of a possible disaster in our area.

Dental Clinic

Located at 21 South Main Street.

Provides urgent and complete dental care for children and adults. NC Medicaid, Health Choice, and self-pay accepted.

Family Planning

Appointments are available for men and women of reproductive age to receive physical exams, family planning counseling, lab tests, and birth control methods. Fees are based on family size and income. Medicaid and some insurances accepted.



STD Clinic/Communicable Disease

Offers screening for diagnosis and prevention of various sexually transmitted diseases, counseling and follow-up assistance. FREE confidential HIV testing available.

Adult Health

Complete physical exams for men and women ages 21 to 64.

Walk-In Clinic

Provides blood pressure readings, full laboratory testing, and urinalysis. Drug testing also available. No appointments necessary.

Breast & Cervical Cancer Control

Program Visits

Physical exams including appropriate pap smears and mammograms for women age 40 to 64 that have no insurance and are income eligible.

CAP DA, CAP Choice, Money Follows the Person

These programs provide an option to nursing home placement for elderly or disabled adults who wish to remain in their home.



Immunizations

Offered for all ages daily, no appointment needed. We follow the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices to recommend and give vaccines.

Child Health

Well-child check-ups for children birth to 21 years old. Accepts Cigna, Medicaid, BlueCross/BlueShield, and private pay.



WIC Program

Supplemental Nutrition Program for **W**omen, **I**nfants, and **C**hildren. Serves eligible pregnant, breastfeeding, and non-breastfeeding postpartum women, infants and children up to age five. WIC is an equal opportunity program.

Breastfeeding Support

Provides breastfeeding women, and those desiring to breastfeed, with classes, books, breast pumps, instruction, and support.

Newborn/Postpartum Assistance

Provides physical assessment for new babies and moms. Education and referrals as needed.



Pregnancy Care Management

A tracking program for Medicaid eligible prenatal women. A nurse will help to identify and access medical, social, and educational needs and work closely with the OB provider to assist in providing for those needs.

Care Coordination for Children (CC4C)

Allows a nurse to address current and ongoing medical and family needs for children ages birth to 5 years , to improve healthier outcomes for the children and their families.
